



GOSPEL REFLECTION: Luke 21:5-19

Luke's Gospel began in the Temple with Zechariah's vision; the infant Jesus was presented in the Temple; the 12-year-old Jesus was "lost" and found in the Temple; and now we find Jesus back in the Temple giving the disciples and the crowds his final teachings. Jesus' words have an edge, creating healthy unease. During these last days of the Church year, as the dark of winter increases, Jesus' words hold deep reminders of how to remain faithful until the end of time.

1. Who are the false teachers in our own day? How do you tell falseness from truth?
2. In light of the world's calamities, how do you refrain from being overwhelmed with fear?
3. As a parish community, how can we best prepare for "the last day"?
